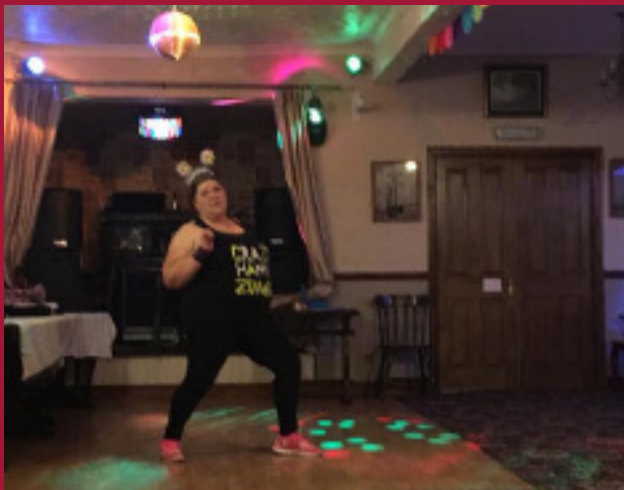
Welcome to our seventh society newsletter for Summer 2017.
